ELECTION SCHEDULE FOR THE ELECTIONS 2026-28

In pursuance of the Trade Organizations Act, 2013 and Rule 14 of the Trade Organizations Rules, 2013 (as amended) read with Article 49 of Memorandum & Article of Association of FCCI; the Executive Committee has approved the following Election Schedule for the years 2026 to 2028 against the vacant seats of Associate Class X 14, Corporate Class X 14 and Women Reserved Seats X 2; in its 22nd meeting held on **14th July, 2026**.

1	The Secretary General shall display Election Schedule on notice board of the FCCI, on website and submit a copy to Regulator.	(Wednesday) 15 th July, 2026
2	The Changes, if any, regarding name of representative appearing in the list of provisional voters shall be sent to the Secretary General of the Chamber alongwith necessary proof of eligibility.	(Saturday) 18 th July, 2026
3	The secretary General shall display the provisional list of all members eligible to vote alongwith their national tax, sales tax registration number if applicable with the name and national identity card number of their representative. (at notice board & website of the chamber).	(Wednesday) 22 nd July, 2026
4	The members who have any objection to the entries/change in the list of provisional voters shall send their objections in writing to the Secretary General.	(Wednesday) 29 th July, 2026
5	The Secretary General will intimate action on the objection or changes sent by members.	(Monday) 3 rd August, 2026
6	Any person aggrieved by the decision of the Secretary General may make a representation to the election commission.	(Thursday) 6 th August, 2026
7	The election commission shall decide the case	(Monday) 10 th August, 2026
8	Any person aggrieved with the decision of the Election Commission may appeal to the Regulator.	(Thursday) 13 th August, 2026
9	The REGULATOR shall decide the case whose decision in this regard shall be final.	(Monday) 24 th August, 2026
10	The final list of voters shall be displayed at notice board and at website of the Chamber and also to submit to the Regulator.	(Wednesday) 26 th August, 2026
11	Any person who is eligible to contest the Election for the vacant posts of the member Executive Committee shall send his nomination duly proposed and seconded by a duly registered voter and signed by the candidate to the Secretary General on the prescribed form in accordance with the Articles of Association or rules of the Chamber. In the same manner women entrepreneurs desiring to contest the election for the reserved seats in the Executive Committee for women will submit nomination papers.	(Monday) 31 st August, 2026
12	A copy of final list of voters shall be provided to each contesting candidate by the Secretary General. (Except, the candidates of the women seats as their electoral college are Executive Committee not the general body).	(Tuesday) 1 st September, 2026
13	Scrutiny of the nomination papers by the commission. This clause ipso facto applies to the nominees of the women seats	(Tuesday) 1 st September, 2026
14	The list of nominees whose papers have been declared valid to be displayed on the notice board and the forms of withdrawal to the said nominees to be issued.	(Tuesday) 1 st September, 2026
15	The objection if any, to the nomination of candidates can be filed to the election commission. This clause ipso facto applies to the nominees of the women seats. Provided that the candidate for a particular seat will file objections for the candidate of the same seat and for the same class.	(Wednesday) 2 nd September, 2026
16	The election commission shall decide the objections filed under the preceding clause. This clause ipso facto applies to the nominees of the women seats.	(Friday) 4 th September, 2026

17	Any candidate aggrieved by the decision of the election commission may file an appeal to the Regulator. This clause ipso facto applies to the nominees of the women seats.	(Monday) 7 th September, 2026
18	The Regulator Trade Organizations shall decide the appeal referred under the preceding clause. This clause ipso facto applies to the nominees of the women seats.	(Monday) 14 th September, 2026
19	Date of receipt, by the Secretary General of the withdrawal forms completed by the nominees who want to withdraw from the Election. This clause ipso facto applies to the nominees of the women seats.	(Tuesday) 15 th September, 2026
20	Display & issuance of final list of candidates for the Election for all the members who are eligible to participate in the election.	(Wednesday) 16 th September, 2026
21	The polling for corporate class at the FCCI Complex	(Monday) 21 st September, 2026
22	The polling for associate class at the FCCI Complex	(Tuesday) 22 nd September, 2026
Counting of votes shall take place immediately after the polling hours under the supervision of Election Commission in the presence of polling agents of the candidates, if any, at the site.		
	Provisional results be declared by the election commission	
23	The election commission shall conduct election for the women reserved seats.	(Wednesday) 23 rd September, 2026
24	Any elected member of Executive Committee shall send his nomination for election as an office bearer duly proposed and seconded by an elected E.C. Member and signed by the candidate to the election commission.	(Friday) 25 th September, 2026
25	Scrutiny of the nomination papers for the election of office bearers by the Commission & display of contesting candidates on notice board.	(Friday) 25 th September, 2026
26	Polling for the election of Office Bearer.	(Monday) 28 th September, 2026
27	In compliance with Trade Organizations Act 2013, Rule (19) of the Trade Organizations Rules, 2013 and FCCI Memorandum and Article of Association, Article 71, The final result of the election of Members of the Executive Committee shall be officially announced at the Annual General Meeting .	Wednesday 30th September, 2026 (AGM)

Explanation:

- 1) For the purpose of this schedule "Day" means working hours of the Chamber on that day unless otherwise stated.
- 2) *If any day on which an act scheduled to be performed under the election schedule falls on a holiday, such act shall be performed on the day next following the holiday (s).

Note:

Polling hours will be from 9:00 A.M to 5:00 P.M with break for lunch and prayer from 01:00 P.M to 02:00 P.M (Polling timings can be extended at the discretion of Election Commission)

Holidays: Due to the expected holidays in respect of Eid-e-Milad-un-Nabi; the Election activities will not be scheduled during Gazetted holidays (subject to the sighting of moon)
